

In studying the maladies of celebrities of the past in the light of modern medicine, the medical historian will find this book indispensable; it will save him many hours of research in the British Museum or other libraries to discover what previous medical authors have said upon the subject being investigated.

The scope of the bibliography has been world-wide; the celebrities, famous and infamous, range from Homer to Hitler. The period covered extends from the earliest publications of which there is any bibliographical record (from about 1600) to 1950, with selected additions to 1961. Comprehensive as are the references some important omissions have been detected, but, as is observed in the introduction, this is inevitable in a compiled bibliography of this character. The work is a lasting memorial to Dr. Judson Bennett Gilbert, urologist, surgeon, scholar, and bibliophile.

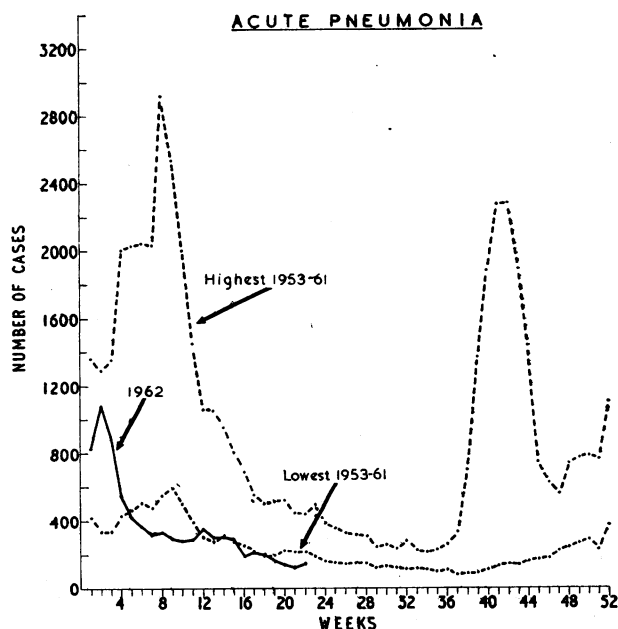
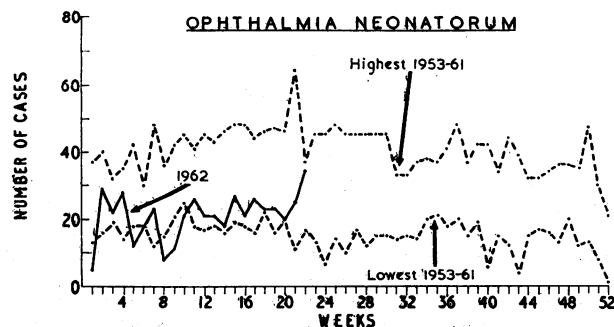
Poliomyelitis in Dundee and Monmouthshire

At the beginning of this week 21 cases of poliomyelitis had occurred in Dundee since the end of May. By June 2 the evidence showed that a localized outbreak of the disease was occurring, confined in the main to two or three housing areas in the north-eastern sector of the city. Twelve of the cases were paralytic and nine non-paralytic, and the great majority were in young children 9 months of age upwards. The four older patients were a man of 38, who died (he was the father of one of the earlier cases); a young man of 19; a girl of 10; and a girl of 7. Seven of the patients were completely unimmunized. The disease is relatively mild, and the evidence points to case-to-case transmission. Type 1 virus has been isolated from two cases. Oral vaccine is being made freely available in Dundee, but the main immunizing effort is concentrated on the affected area of the city. Between June 11 and June 19 25,000 doses of oral vaccine had been administered, 14,000 through health-authority clinics and 11,000 through family doctors. We are indebted to Dr. I. B. L. Weir, medical officer of health of Dundee, for this information.

Five cases of poliomyelitis from Ebbw Vale, Monmouthshire, and its neighbourhood were under treatment in a hospital near Newport at the beginning of this week, and there had been one death (in an unvaccinated child aged 4). Four of the patients under treatment are under 5 years of age and one is 7. Three of these 5 children had not been vaccinated, and 2 had had three injections, one three years ago and the other had the third injection last October. Type 1 virus has been isolated. We are indebted to Dr. T. Stephens, medical officer of health of Ebbw Vale, for this information.
