

devoted to heterotransplantation of the kidney, one to transplantation of organs other than the kidney, and one to the ethical problems relating to transplantation.

This is essentially a practical book, written by a clinician and addressed primarily to

clinicians. As such it is invaluable and should be read by everyone concerned with organ transplantation in man. The book can also be recommended to biologists, who may perhaps be surprised to learn how much observations made on man have already con-

tributed to our understanding of transplantation immunology, and also to what extent progress on the clinical front is contingent on advances not only in immunology but in many other fields as well.
