Heart Disease in Children. Diagnosis and Treatment. By Benjamin M. Gasul, M.D., M.S., René A. Arcilla, M.D., and Maurice Lev, B.S., M.D. (Pp. 1,363 + xxiv; illustrated, £12.) Philadelphia : J. B. Lippincott. London : Pitman. 1966.

This book originates in Chicago from Cook County Children's Hospital and the University of Illinois School of Medicine. It is in a sense a memorial to the senior author, the late Dr. B. M. Gasul, who conceived it and died during its period of gestation.

There are in fact 12 other contributors in addition to the three authors, all from the same centre. This doubtless accounts for a welcome consistency in manner and quality of presentation, and the absence of overlapping. The clinical features of heart disease in its many forms in infancy and childhood are excellently described in a detailed and systematic fashion. There are also valuable and unusually practical chapters on radiography, electrocardiography, and vectorcardiography, cardiac catheterization, and angiocardiography. The detailed discussions of cardiac catheterization and angiocardiography will be particularly welcome to readers in view of their now almost universal use as essential diagnostic procedures. The earlier chapters in the book include beautifully illustrated accounts of the anatomy, embryology, and haemodynamics of the foetal and postnatal cardiovascular systems. Indeed,

graphs, electrocardiographs, and line-drawings

-are of the highest quality. There have been a number of excellent textbooks on heart disease in childhood in the past 15 years, and an addition to this number has to be something special to justify its publication. This book will have no difficulty in passing the test. Its excellence is largely due to the fact that its content is based upon the work of one centre with vast case material and the highest standards of practice. In the reviewer's opinion this is the best textbook yet published on the subject. It will be of value not only to paediatricians, paediatric cardiologists, and postgraduate students but also to general cardiologists and cardiac surgeons. It is good value even at £12.
