Diabetes Campaign

The 50th anniversary of the discovery of insulin is being marked by a campaign by the British Diabetic Association to raise £500,000 for research into the disease and its social consequences. Professor Charles Best, F.R.S., a vice-president of the association will lecture at the Royal Society on 19 April to an invited audience as part of the campaign, and a travelling exhibition will tour the country.

Growth by Wellcome

Sales by the Wellcome Foundation rose by 14% to £86 million in the year ending August 1970. In its annual report the Foundation announced that exports rose by 36% to £12.6 million, and the expenditure on research and development rose by 29% to £5.8 million. The profit before tax fell from £9.6 million to £8.7 million.
