

governing bodies of the hospitals. It also urged that all doctors should have access to some hospital facilities. Most of these old controversies are now dead ashes, though the one last mentioned still burns brightly.

Most voluntary hospitals were chronically short of money, but contributory schemes, developed between the wars and on which the Association made pungent comments, helped to bridge the gap between income and expenditure. In 1931 "the historic conflict between the general practitioners and

the voluntary hospitals . . . was revived, fanned by the new potential challenge of the contributory schemes." Government payments during the last war, particularly for keeping beds empty and ready to receive casualties, helped to fill their coffers, but by then it was too late, and nationalization when it came received little open opposition.

A second volume by Mr. Robert Pinker incorporating statistical studies is promised and a book on the Metropolitan Asylums Board by Miss Gwen Ayers is also in hand.

There are few errors of fact. Sir Bertrand (later Lord) Dawson is twice referred to as Dr. "Bernard Dawson" and it is stated that Dr. Addison was the only doctor ever to be Minister of Health. The late Dr. Walter E. Elliot held that office from 1937 until 1940.

The book is a valuable study of an important section of social development and is fascinating to anyone who has lived through the years when the ferment of change was at work. It is highly commended.
