

temporary stay, from which he ordinarily looks forward to a return to family life.

Incidentally, the authors, one a psychoanalyst and the other a children's officer, believe that the 16 years since 1948—when the new child care service took shape—have

been a period of tension in which the clash of feeling and opinion has not always operated to the benefit of the child; some workers have been preoccupied with physical hygiene, others with administrative convenience, others with monetary economy,

others with committee appraisal—and a few in each group have been preoccupied with doctrinaire theories.

A book interesting, and stimulating, to most people interested in child health.
