

Hexachlorophane in Medicines

The Department of Health and Social Security announces that from 30 July importing, selling, or supplying medicinal products containing hexachlorophane will be prohibited except in certain circumstances. Among the exceptions are medicinal products containing 0.1% or less of hexachlorophane; soaps containing up to 2% and other products containing up to 0.75%, which will be on sale in pharmacies only; and on prescription, aerosols containing more than 0.1%, soap containing more than 2%, and other medicinal compounds containing more than 0.75% hexachlorophane. Labels stating the content must be on all such products. *The Medicines (Hexachlorophane Prohibition) Order 1973*. Statutory Instrument No. 1973/1120. H.M.S.O., price 8p.
