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Cancer Research Campaign

Rapidly rising costs led to an excess of expenditure over income of £641 000 in 1974, says the annual report of the Cancer Research Campaign. Much of the income came from the work of the Campaign's 800 local committees, and the total for the year reached a new high of £4.7m., but this was not enough to cope with 20-25% rises in salaries and the costs of raw materials. However, the campaign is optimistic about the chances of achieving its programme of establishing departments of clinical oncology in six British universities. It is also continuing a policy of setting up personal chairs to give established research workers the security to pursue a career in a particular field. Current research projects supported by the campaign total 444 at 40 centres in the United Kingdom and a few overseas.
