monly administer it in a gummy solution, five decigrammes (ten grains) of the salt dissolved in 100 grammes of the fluid. One of its great advantages is, that it can be easily dissolved in oil, and thus serve for frictions and embrocations over the spleen. For this purpose we have used the following liniment:—

60 grammes of olive oil.

1 gramme of valerianate of quinine.

In neuralgia we commonly employ pills of six centigrammes each, made up in the most simple manner.—Gazette Médicale de Paris.
