

**THE SUSPECTED POISONING AT RUGELEY.** In compliance with the request of the Secretary of State, the bodies of the prisoner Palmer's wife and brother were exhumed on December 21st, under the superintendence of Chief Superintendent Bergen, and were conveyed from the churchyard to the Talbot Inn. At one o'clock, a jury of twenty-three persons, principally tradesmen of Rugeley, was empanelled to investigate the case. The body of Walter Palmer was encased in a strong leaden coffin, but that of Mrs. Palmer in an oak coffin only. After being sworn, the jury proceeded to view the bodies, which were much decomposed, but the features of both were recognisable to a great extent. Evidence was afterwards taken before the coroner as to the identity of the bodies; a young man named Wooliams identifying that of Walter Palmer, and a woman named Rowley that of Ann Palmer. The *post mortem* examination was made by Dr. Moncton, assisted by one or two medical assistants; and the contents of the stomach and intestines were subsequently sent to Dr. Taylor, of Guy's Hospital, for analysis. The inquiry was then adjourned.

**ACADEMY OF MEDICINE IN PARIS.** The election of office-bearers took place on December 18th, when there were elected: *President*, M. Bussy; *Vice-President*, M. Michel Lévy; *Annual Secretary*, M. Depaul; *Members of Council*, MM. Michel Lévy, Roche, and Segalas.

**ACADEMY OF MEDICINE IN PARIS: PRIZES.** At the meeting of this body on December 11th, the following prizes were awarded. *Prize of the Academy*, value 1000 francs, to Dr. Jules Rochard, chief-surgeon of the imperial navy at Brest; subject, "To determine by accurate facts the amount of influence which changes of locality, such as emigration to warm countries and sea voyages, exercise on the progress of pulmonary tuberculosis." *Portal prize*, of 1000 francs; subject, "Endemic goitre; its causes, pathological anatomy, prophylaxis, and relations to cretinism." The prize was not awarded; but two sums of 400 francs each were awarded as encouragement to Dr. Bach of Strasburg and Dr. Morélin of Jura, and the sum of 200 francs to Dr. le Tertre Vallier of Amiens. *Civrieux prize*, value 1000 francs; subject, "Cataplexy;" divided between Dr. F. Sabouraud, of Châtaignererie, department of Vendée, and Dr. T. Puel, of Paris. *Capuron prize*, value 1500 francs; subject, "Determine by medical observation the physiological and therapeutic action of alkaline mineral waters, and point out accurately the cases in which they should be used." This prize has been awarded to M. Pétrequin, formerly chief-surgeon of the Hôtel-Dieu at Lyons, and M. Socquet, physician of the same institution; Dr. Willemm, assistant-inspector of the mineral waters at Vichy, received honourable mention. *Itard triennial prize*, value 3700 francs; awarded to M. Vidal (of Cassis), surgeon of the Hôpital du Midi, for his Treatise on Venereal Diseases. A prize of 1500 francs was distributed among M. Massaloup, of the canton of Mèze; M. Labesque, of Agen; and M. Carville, of Gaillon, for their zeal in vaccination: four gold medals, and one hundred silver medals were also awarded to various practitioners who had either distinguished themselves by the number of vaccinations which they had performed, or by memoirs on small-pox communicated to the Academy. Medals of silver and bronze, and honourable mention, were awarded to several practitioners for their investigations on epidemics, and on mineral waters.

The following subjects have been proposed by the Academy for prizes. For 1856: *Prize of the Academy*: 1000 francs. Subject: "Give a history of the applications of the microscope to pathological anatomy, and to the diagnosis and treatment of diseases: point out the services which this instrument may have rendered to medicine; state those which it may yet render, and give precautions against the errors to which it may lead." *Portal prize*: 1000 francs. Subject: "The pathological anatomy of cysts." *Civrieux prize*: 2000 francs. Subject: "Establish by facts the differences between neuralgia and neuritis." *Capuron prize*: 1000 francs. Subject: "Blood-letting in pregnancy." The *Argenteuil prize*: 12,000 francs, will be awarded to the author of the most remarkable improvement in the treatment of urethral stricture, from 1850 to 1856; or, secondarily, to the author, within the same period, of the best treatise on other diseases of the urinary passages. For 1857: *Prize of the Academy*: Subject: "Determine by clinical facts the value of permanent emunctories in chronic diseases." *Portal Prize*. Subject: "Describe the organic changes produced by rheumatism, and determine the characters by which they may be distinguished from pathological changes arising from other causes." *Civrieux*

*prize*. Subject: "Nervous vertigo: its differential diagnosis, the distinctive characters of vertigo arising from plethora, from anæmia, and from organic cerebral lesions, and the treatment proper to each form." *Capuron prizes* of 1,000 francs each. Subjects: "Sudden death in the puerperal state." "Saline mineral waters; the sources which may be ranged in this class; determine, by observation, of their physiological and therapeutic action; and the chronic diseases in which they should be used." *Lefèvre prize* of 1,800 francs. Subject: "Melancholia." For 1858. *Itard triennial prize*, of 3,000 francs, to the author of the best work or memoir on practical medicine or therapeutics which has been published at least two years. All candidates, except those for the Itard and Argenteuil prizes, whose names become known, will be excluded from competition.
