Blanchard (Wolson); J. B. Robertson (Marton); G. F. Whateley (Crick); and S. B. Bucknill, M.D. (Rugby). It was resolved:—

1. That the thanks of the meeting be given to Mr. Griffin for his exertions in the cause of the union medical officers.
2. That the meeting entirely concurs in the suggestions contained in Mr. Griffin's letter, and that the members will give him their best support.
3. That a subscription of 5s. a quarter be entered into to defray the necessary expenses.

## MEETING OF MEDICAL OFFICERS AT READING.

A very large and influential meeting was held at the Great Western Hotel, Reading, on Wednesday, Feb. 20th, consisting of medical officers of the Reading, Wokingham, Henley, Bradfield, Hartley Wintney, Newbury, Wallingford, Basingstoke, and Easthampstead Unions, in support of the movement commenced by Mr. Griffin of Weymouth. The Mayor of Reading (T. L. Walford, Esq.) in the chair. There were present:—Messrs. Vines, Walford, and Workman (Reading); Luce, and G. May, jun. (Wokingham); Jeston, Brookes, and Young (Henley); Smith, Kidgell, and Waldron (Bradfield); McIntyre, M.D. (Hartley Wintney); Ball (Basingstoke); Watts (Newbury); Breach (Wallingford). Letters were received from other medical officers of these unions, expressing their hearty concurrence in the object of the meeting, and their regret at being unavoidably absent. The meeting was also favoured with the support of Drs. Cowan and Wells, and other influential members of the Association; and the greatest unanimity and cordiality prevailed.

The following resolutions were proposed, and carried unanimously:—

1. That this meeting pledges itself to further the movement commenced by Mr. Griffin for a more equitable adjustment of the remuneration to Poor-law medical officers.
2. That this meeting considers the present mode of payment objectionable, affording as it does facilities for the guardians and overseers to grant relief indiscriminately at the expense of the medical officers; and it considers that the mode of remuneration at per case, as proposed and recommended by the Poor-law Commissioners, in their minute dated June 6th, 1839, and repeated in 1841 (*Vide ASSOCIATION MEDICAL JOURNAL*, Dec. 26th, 1855), is that which will best secure the interests of the patients, and that also of the medical officers.
3. That the remuneration of the medical officers be paid entirely out of the Consolidated Fund.
4. That the list of cases classed under "extra medical fees" be extended.
5. That, for the efficient carrying out of these resolutions, it is expedient that a petition from each union be presented to the House of Commons, and that the county and borough members be earnestly requested to support its prayer.
6. That Messrs. Luce and Young be the secretaries of the associated medical officers of these unions, and that one or both of them be requested to attend as a deputation at the meeting to be held in London; and that a committee be formed, consisting of Messrs. Vines, Walford, and Workman, to assist the secretaries in carrying out the objects of this meeting.
7. That the secretaries be requested to apply to the medical officers of these unions for a contribution of 5s., for the purposes specified in Mr. Griffin's letter on the subject (*ASSOCIATION JOURNAL*, Dec. 21st, 1855); and that, if necessary, they be authorised to apply for a further contribution.
8. That the cordial thanks of this meeting be given to Mr. Griffin for his unceasing and disinterested exertions on behalf of the union medical officers.
9. That a copy of the foregoing resolutions be forwarded to the medical officers who have been unable to attend this meeting, to Mr. Griffin, and to the medical journals.

At the close of the meeting, the company present dined together; and, after the usual loyal and other appropriate toasts had been drunk, they adjourned to the meeting of the Reading Pathological Society, at the Royal Berks Hospital.

POPULAR MEDICAL SUPERSTITION IN THE OLDEN TIMES. We have doubtless all heard of the old belief in the efficacy of the skull of a person who has died a violent death, as a remedy

for epilepsy. Subjoined are two curious official documents, translated from the *Revue Médico-Chirurgicale de Paris* for November 1855.

"I. To Monsieur the Criminal Lieutenant-General and President of the Seneschals Court of Lyons.

"Sieur Claude Pessonneau, mercer, of that town, humbly prays and assures you that, for eight years, he has been subject to epilepsy, which attacks him almost daily, even several times a day, and entirely deprives him of consciousness. And, as he has been informed that several medical authors promise a cure from the administration of a specific remedy composed of various roots and the skull of a man who has died a violent death—a remedy which, when properly prepared, has the reputation of being most efficacious, according to the certificates which M. Hédoïn, physician to the King, and *agrégé* of the College of Medicine at Lyons, and the sieur Aubernon, surgeon, of Lyons, have to-day given under their seal, which certifies your petitioner shows and sets forth to you; and as he has been informed that a criminal, condemned by your judgment to be hanged, is about to be executed—

"May it please you, monsieur, to permit him, after the execution of this miserable person, to remove the skull of his head, in order to employ it in the preparation of this remedy; and he will consider himself bound to continue in prayer to God for your prosperity and health. "PESSONNEAUX."

"Let this be shown to the Procureur-Général of Lyons. 30th October, 1706. "CLARET LA TOURRETTE."

"On behalf of the King, I do not forbid the conclusions of the present request. Lyons, 30 November, 1706. (Signature illegible.)"

"Let it be done according to the decree of the Procureur-Général. Lyons, 30 November, 1706.

"CLARET LA TOURRETTE."

"II. To Monsieur the Criminal Lieutenant-General in the Seneschals Court of Lyons.

"The sisters, rector, and governors of the General Alms-house in Lyons humbly pray and assure you that they require in pharmacy several skulls of persons who have died violent deaths, in order to use them in the composition of several very necessary remedies; among others, of one against epilepsy, to which several persons in the above named house are subject. They are therefore obliged to have recourse to you.

"May it please you, monsieur, considering the necessity above pointed out, and for the good of the poor, to permit the surgeon of the aforesaid house to select and remove from the burying place of the penitent Sisters of Mercy such skulls as they may find proper for the preparation of the aforesaid remedies; and, to this end, the said penitent sisters shall be invited to permit the said memorial, and the poor of the said alms-house will pray for your prosperity and health.
