INDICATIONS FOR USE

In all Gastric conditions where it is found that curd is not digested, Gastritis, Gastro-Enteritis, Gastric Catarrh, Gastric Ulcer, Gastric Influenza, Obstinate Vomiting. In all Acute Disorders. Before and after Surgical Operations. In Convalescence, Gouty Dyspepsia, Insomnia, (taken last thing at night it promotes refreshing sleep and digestive rest), Neurasthenia. All forms of Tuberculosis. In Senile Disorders of the Digestion. When pure milk is not obtainable, viz., on Board Ship, in Tropical Countries or Distant Lands, or whenever a light nourishment is required. For the Invalid, Dyspeptic, and the Aged it is an essential nutrient.

ADVANTAGES

Most invalids' foods require cow's milk to be used in their preparation; this involves much time and careful mixing to avoid the presence of burnt milk or lumpiness—common characteristics of foods so prepared.
