EXAMPLE:

At age 30 an annual premium of £13 8s. 6d. will insure the following benefits—During incapacity from alliess or accident. £3 3. per week for first 26 weeks, and £1 11s. 6d. per week during remainder of illness to age 65. At age 65 or previous death, £300

Siekness and accident claims are paid every week by cheque, and death claims on production of satisfactory evidence. Survival claims are paid on the 65th birthday.
