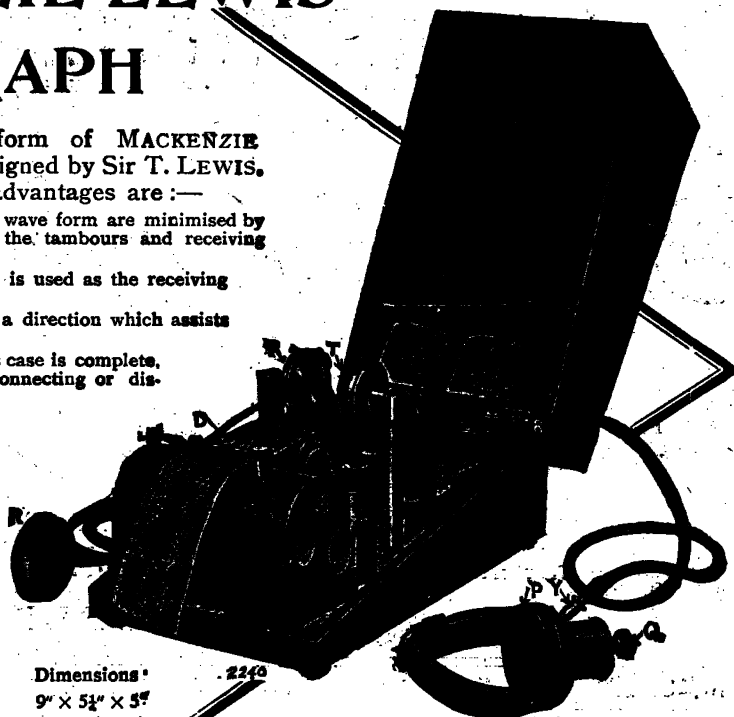


# The MACKENZIE-LEWIS POLYGRAPH

- (2) The glycerine pelotte is used as the receiving chamber.
- (3) The paper passes in a direction which assists the ink to flow.
- (4) The instrument in its case is complete, ready for use, no connecting or disconnecting required.
