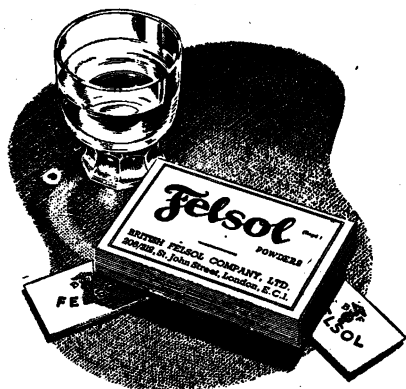


THE THERAPY OF ASTHMA
