The case of the Culicine larvae . . .





Another (4) found that there was no evidence of the irritation, congestion, discomfort or pain that would follow from blocking of the flow. He agreed with other observers that, where there was initial fear of incomplete absorption, actual trial brought reassurance. Most women having tried tampons, decided not to return to the use of external pads.

Intelligently used, vaginal tampons represent a decided advance in feminine hygiene. They may be recommended with confidence.


