the return of consciousness after coma or delirium,
rational thinking after confusion,
a co-operative and calm outlook after resistance or depression.

This changed attitude must be maintained by repeated injections while the patient is being given other treatment suitable for the underlying condition, whether this is psychotic or somatic in origin.

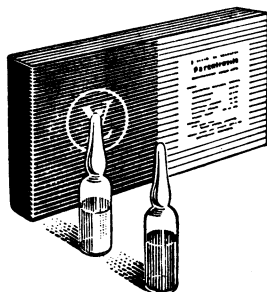
High potency preparations are available for both intravenous and intramuscular use to detoxicate patients at the beginning of treatment, and lower potencies for subsequent maintenance.

The use of EURAX in treating patients suffering from pruritus of varying origin is reported on most favourably. One report (*Brit. J. 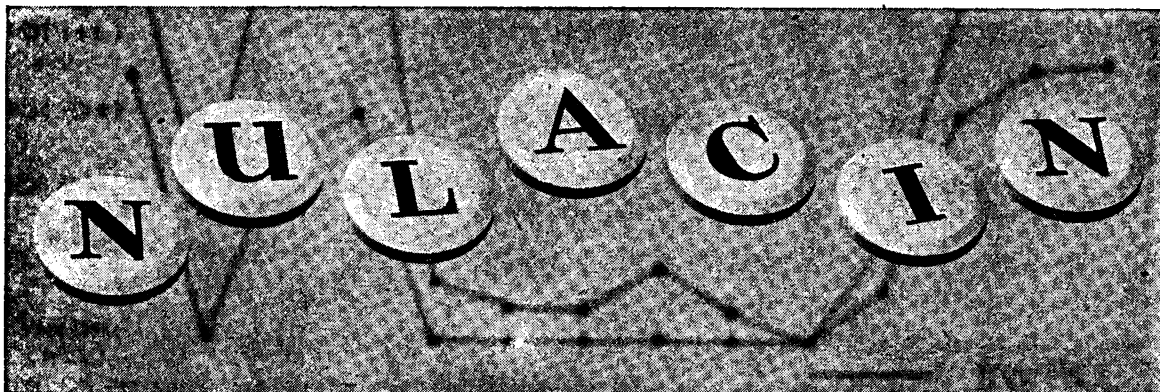

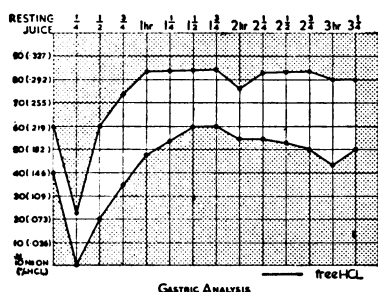

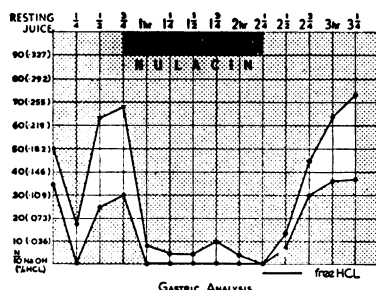

Other Grades, Whole-time

(a) **REGISTRAR**: Posts obtained normally not less than two years after registration as a medical practitioner and held normally for two years: £850 per annum in the first year; £965 per annum in the second and any subsequent years.

(b) **SENIOR REGISTRAR**: Posts obtained normally not less than four years after registration as a medical practitioner and held normally for four years: £1,100 per annum in the first year; £1,200 per annum in the second year; £1,300 per annum in the third year; £1,400 per annum in any subsequent years.

Registrar Grades, Whole-time

(a) HOUSE OFFICERS:

(i) *Provisionally registered medical practitioners*: £425 per annum for the first post held; £475 per annum for the second and all subsequent posts held;

provided that the employing authority (subject in the case of a Hospital Management Committee to the consent of the Regional Hospital Board) shall have discretion to determine that the remuneration of any officer holding his first post in the National Health Service as a House Officer shall be £475 per annum if they are satisfied that the officer has held at least one hospital post outside, of not less than six months' duration, involving clinical responsibilities equivalent to those of house posts in the National Health Service and supervised by appropriate specialist staff.

(ii) *Fully registered medical practitioners*: £525 per annum for any post held; provided that in exceptional circumstances, subject to the consent of the Minister, this rate may be exceeded by up to £50 per annum where a post cannot be filled otherwise.

In each case under sub-sections (i) and (ii) above, a deduction of £125 per annum in respect of board and lodging and other services provided shall be made and each post shall be tenable for six months.

(b) **SENIOR HOUSE OFFICER**: Posts obtained normally not less than one year (in Scotland, two years) after registration as a medical practitioner and normally held for one year only: £745 per annum.

(c) **JUNIOR HOSPITAL MEDICAL OFFICER**: Officers who have held house appointments but who are not Registrars and who have less responsibility than other hospital officers of non-consulant status: £775 (for an officer appointed not less than one year after full registration as a medical practitioner) by £50 to £1,075 per annum.

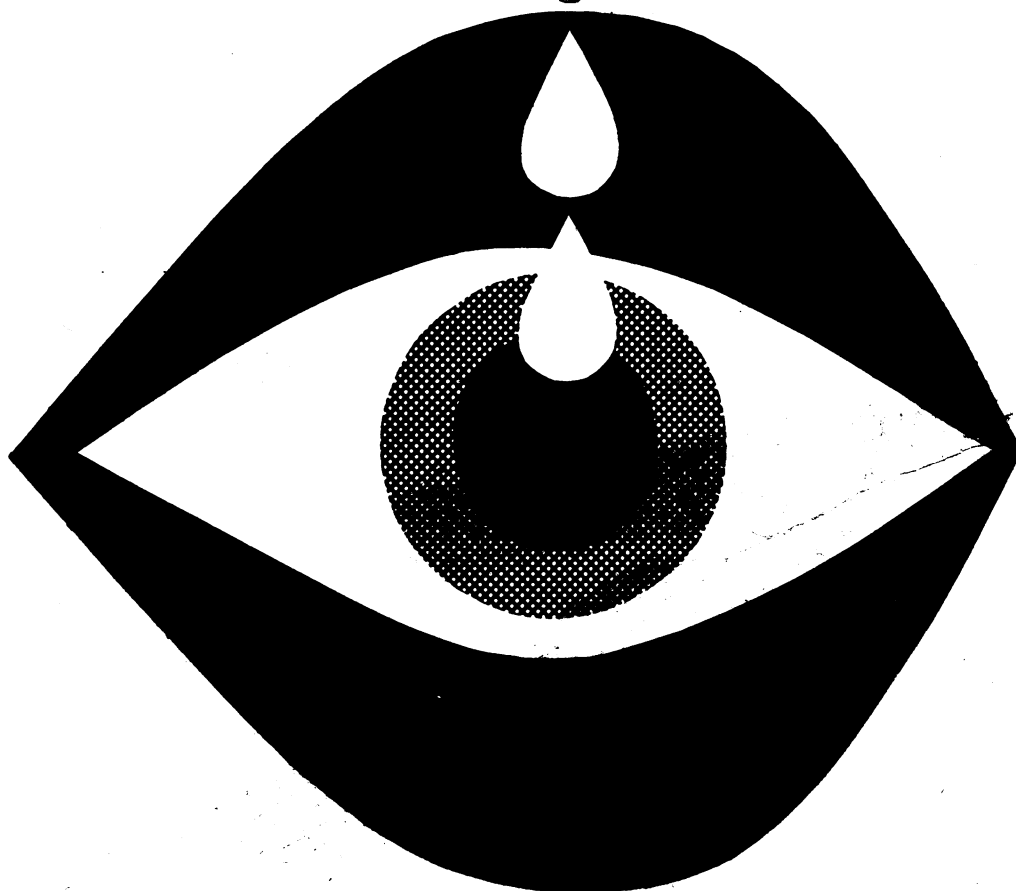
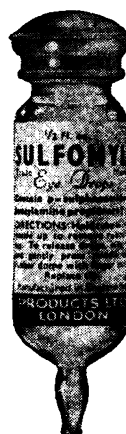
