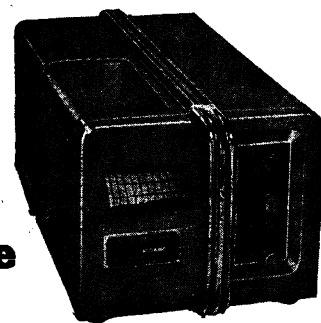

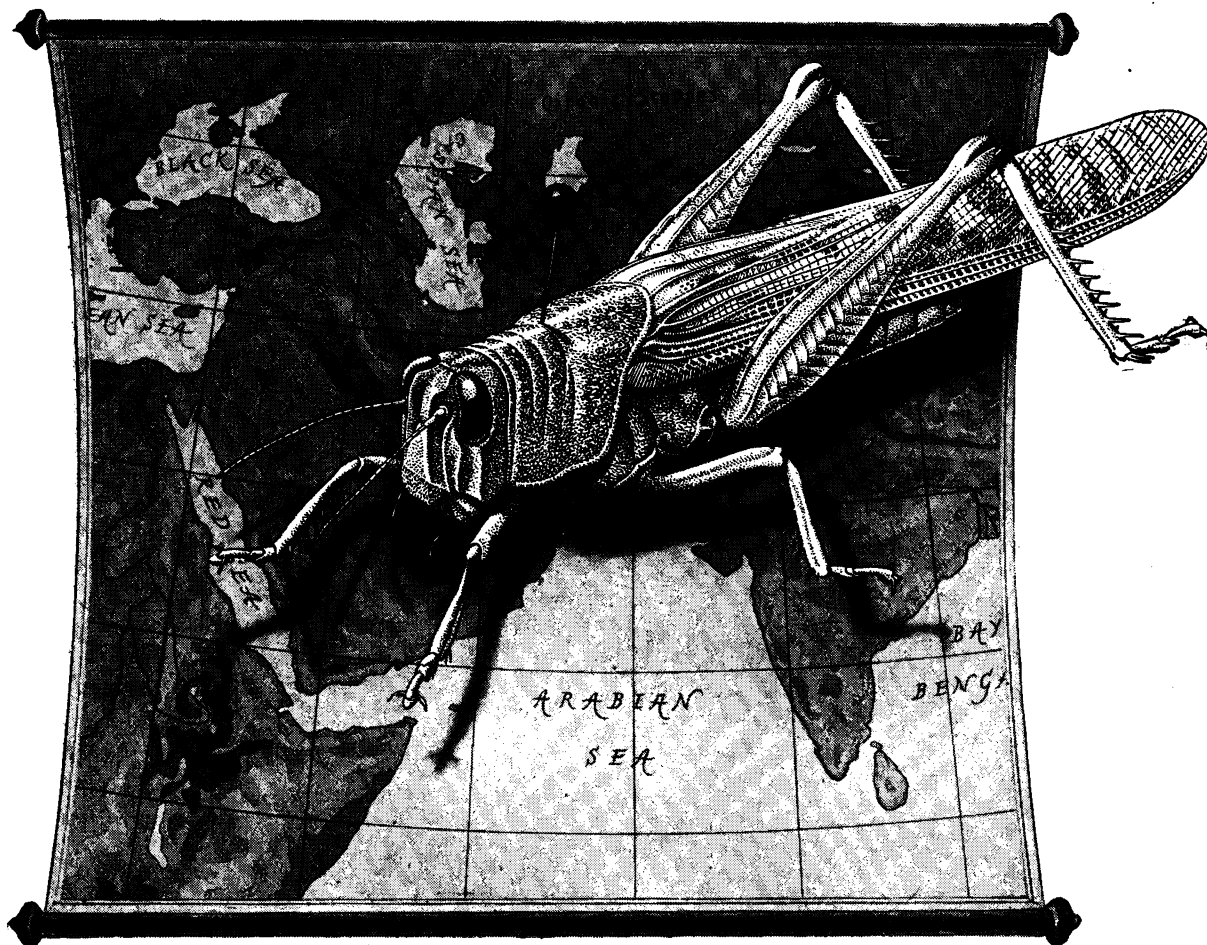

The case of *Schistocerca gregaria* . . .
