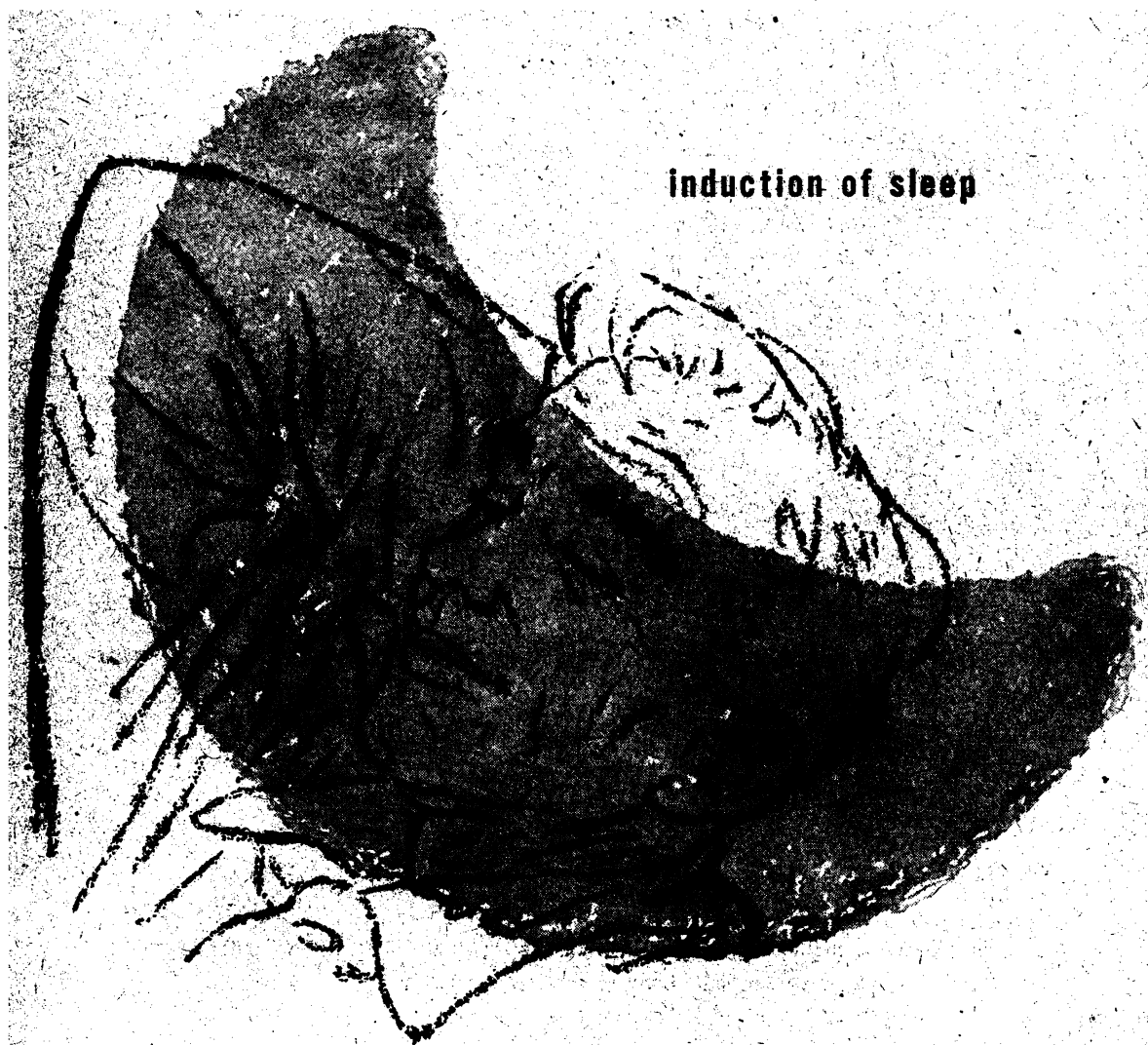

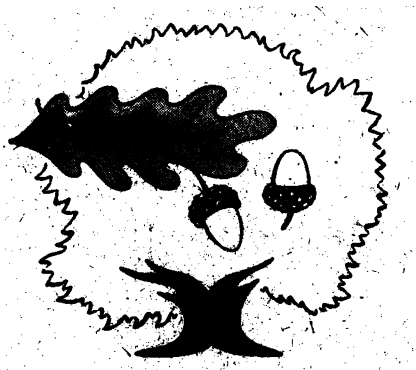

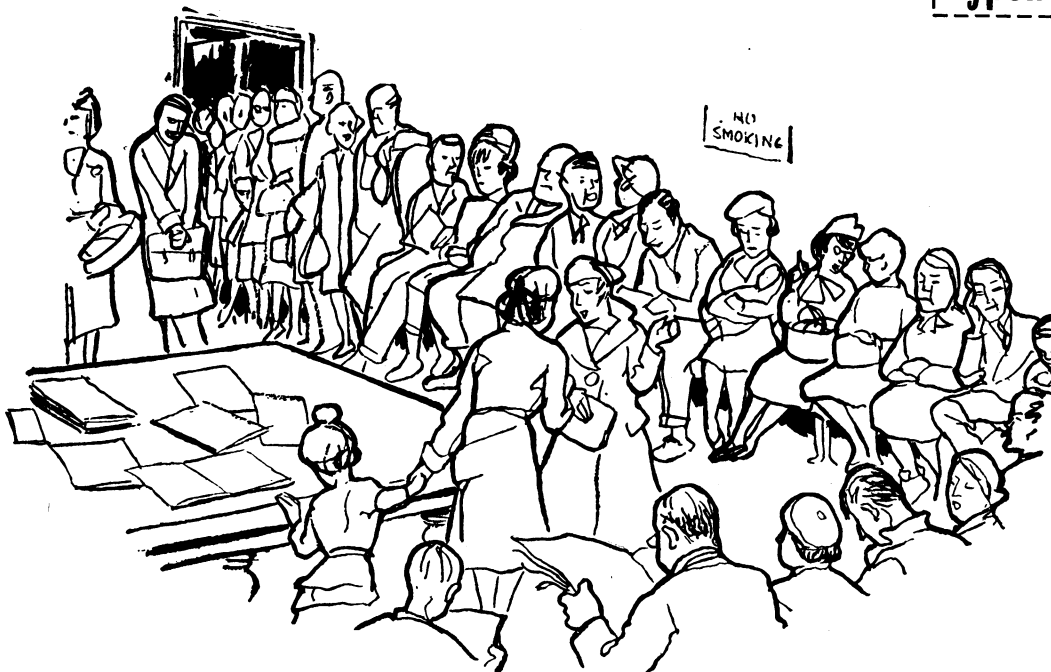

a high standard of hygiene is encouraged and personal comfort increased

There is abundant clinical evidence to support the widespread and increasing use of tampons for the internal absorption of the menstrual flow. Research work conducted in Britain and America over the past 16 years (1-7) has shown conclusively that vaginal tampons properly used are in no way prejudicial to health.

Women welcome them because of the extra comfort and because they are now able to indulge in social activities and sports with a greater sense of physical and mental freedom. One observer (6) found that elimination of pads, pins and belts, and of the chafing and itching caused by the usual external pads were factors greatly in favour of tampons. Another observer (7) noted that 93.6% of her subjects preferred to go on using tampons once they had tried them, rather than return to perineal pads, and many workers stress the freedom from odour and vaginal and uræthral infection of peri-anal origin.

Intelligently used, vaginal tampons represent a decided advance in feminine hygiene. They may be recommended with confidence.
