

(b) **SENIOR HOUSE OFFICER**: Posts obtained normally not less than one year (in Scotland, two years) after registration as a medical practitioner and normally held for one year only: £745 per annum.

(c) **JUNIOR HOSPITAL MEDICAL OFFICER**: Officers who have held house appointments but who are not Registrars and who have less responsibility than other hospital officers of non-consultant status: £775 (for an officer appointed not less than one year after full registration as a medical practitioner) by £50 to £1,075 per annum.
