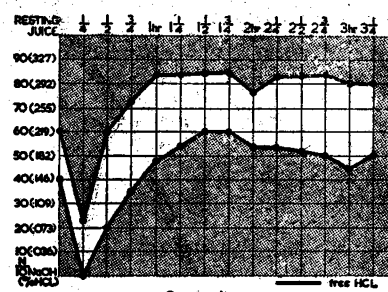

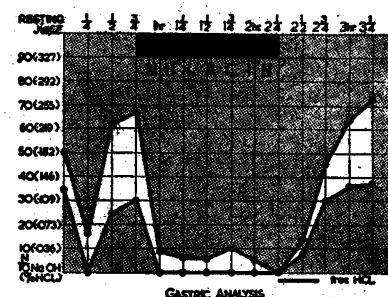

In each case under sub-sections (i) and (ii) above, a deduction of £125 per annum in respect of board and lodging and other services provided shall be made and each post shall be tenable for six months.

(b) **SENIOR HOUSE OFFICER**: Posts obtained by fully registered medical practitioners and held normally for one year only: £819 10s. per annum. If the post is resident a deduction of £150 per annum is made.

(c) **JUNIOR HOSPITAL MEDICAL OFFICER**: Officers who have held house appointments but who are neither Senior House Officers nor in one of the registrar grades, who have less responsibility than other hospital officers of non-consultant status, and who have been appointed for a limited or an indefinite period, not less than one year after full registration as a medical practitioner: £852 10s. by £55 to £1,182 10s. per annum. If the post is resident a deduction of £170 per annum is made.
