£825 per annum for the third and any subsequent posts held; deduction of £165 per annum for compulsory residence or £195 per annum for voluntary residence: provided that the employing authority (subject in the case of a Hospital Management Committee to the consent of the Regional Hospital Board) shall have discretion to determine that the remuneration of any officer holding his first post in the National Health Service as a House Officer shall be £750 per annum if they are satisfied that the officer has held at least one hospital post outside, of not less than six months' duration, involving clinical responsibilities equivalent to those of house posts in the National Health Service and supervised by appropriate specialist staff; provided further that where a House Officer has previously held two such outside posts the employing authority (subject in the case of a Hospital Management Committee to the consent of the Regional Hospital Board) shall have discretion to determine that his remuneration shall be £825 per annum. Any House Officer who on first appointment is paid at the appropriate rate to the second or third post held in accordance with the above provision shall be paid at the third post rate for any subsequent appointments in this grade.


