Psoriasis

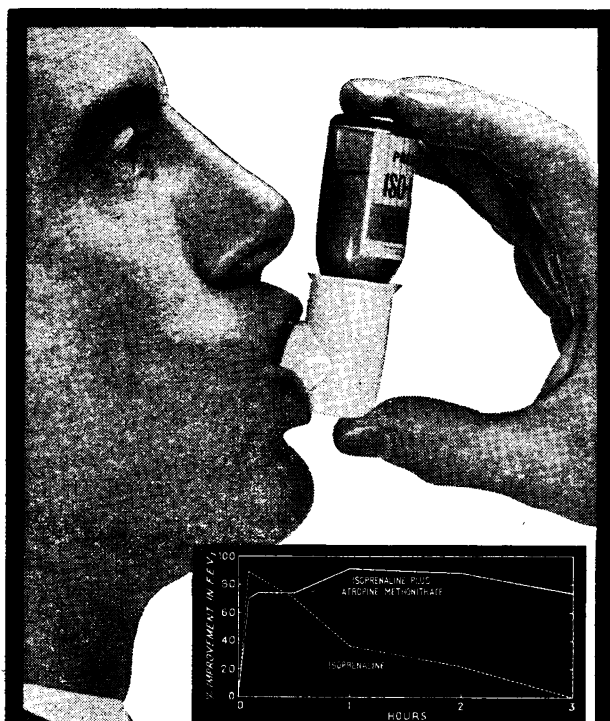

Availability of Vitamins in Yeast

Deficiencies of single factors of the Vitamin B Group do not occur. 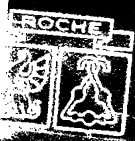

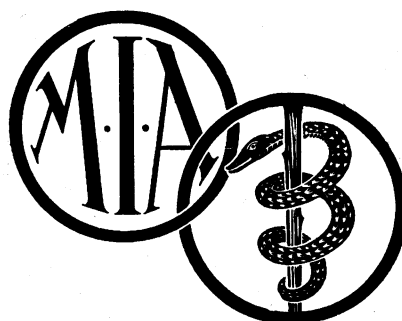
