

Intestinal intoxication

PROPERTIES. — Lactobacilline checks intestinal putrefaction.

By virtue of its composition and perfected preparation Lactobacilline presents the advantage of being insoluble in water, saliva and the gastric contents. It only passes into solution in the intestine at the precise moment when the contained lactic bacilli are required to proliferate and produce their effects. It is in the intestinal contents that these bacilli meet with the conditions of temperature and nutrition most favourable to their development. It is in the intestine therefore that they elaborate the nascent lactic acid upon which their action depends.

INDICATIONS. — Lactobacilline is indicated in all forms of intestinal intoxication, enteritis, diarrhoea, dermatoses. . .

DOSES. — 3 to 9 tablets a day.
