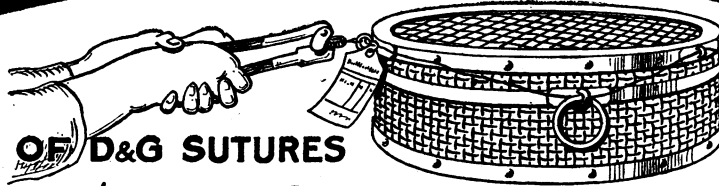


SAFEGUARDS IN STERILIZING D&G SUTURES

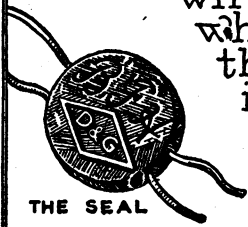
SEALING
THE CAGES OF D&G SUTURES

STERILIZATION

Still Another Precautionary Measure

is to securely fasten each cage with a wire and lead seal, and the firm member whose duty it is to personally superintend the sterilizing procedure inscribes his initials on the seal. By him only may the seal subsequently be broken. Within each cage are sealed bacteriologic controls and an autoindicating thermometer.
