

A DIAGNOSTIC SET WITH ELECTRIC HEAD LAMP



This set contains components of the popular 3004 outfit with a Wickham Electric Head Lamp working from the battery handle.

To assist in manipulating the various instruments a useful inspection handle—Plandle—is provided.

The Head Lamp uses an ordinary spot light bulb which, with a carefully designed optical system, produces a brilliant patch of even illumination adjustable from one to ten inches in diameter.

It is light and having a sponge rubber washable forehead pad is hygienic and very comfortable to wear.

The Plandle facilitates the handling of separate components in awkward corners, thus allowing the battery handle to be placed out of the way in the pocket or on the table.

Set No. 3010 contains May Ophthalmoscope (which can be supplied with illuminated and magnified numbers if required), Auriscope and 3 Specula, Duplay Nasal Specula, Bent arm lamp, with one each Laryngeal and post-nasal Mirrors, Flat Tongue Depressor, Plandle, Wickham Head Lamp, large battery handle and spare lamp complete in a case lined with fadeless fabrics.
