This distinguished book is the work of 144 of *America's foremost teacher-specialists*—each an authority upon the subject on which he writes—each actively engaged in practising the methods he describes. The *New (5th) Edition* is the result of the most severe and extensive revision ever given this book.

10 *entirely new articles have been added*, 30 others *completely rewritten*, many others heavily revised and all discussions throughout the book carefully edited and brought into step with modern medical progress. Then there has been another very important addition—131 *new illustrations*. Every illustration in "Cecil" has been included because it really illustrates some point valuable in the practice and study of medicine.

For instance, there is an especially large section on Infectious Diseases covering 492 pages. There are fully detailed considerations of Diseases due to Physical and Chemical Agents, the Intoxications, Deficiency Diseases, Metabolic

Diseases, Respiratory Diseases, etc. There are 190 pages on Digestive Diseases, 162 pages on the Circulatory System, 198 pages on the Nervous System, and 106 pages on Diseases of the Ductless Glands.
