Andrews Liver Salt is the popular pleasant-tasting effervescent aperient. Its reliable laxative action is due to its being an effervescent saline supplemented by magnesium sulphate the osmotic action of which ensures the retention of sufficient fluid in the bowel for easy and painless evacuation. The magnesium sulphate in Andrews has a further advantage. It increases the flow of bile from the gall-bladder and so assists the later stages of digestion.

Andrews has a sedative action on the stomach and an alkalinising effect in the bloodstream. It counteracts errors of diet, and is useful in indigestion, sickness and sick headaches.

Andrews may be confidently prescribed in pregnancy and lactation, whereas stronger purgatives might be harmful. It produces no

violent disturbances in the system and does not affect the secretion of milk when used in doses recommended.

Large repeated doses of Andrews may also be given as a hydragogue purgative in treating oedema, ascites, pleuritic effusions and nephritis.

Whenever a laxative is called for, Andrews may safely be prescribed, even for delicate adults and children.

DOSE : As a laxative, the usual dose is 2 teaspoonfuls in a glass of water, but this should be adjusted to individual needs and, for children, graduated according to age.
