HEALING AND THE TIME FACTOR . . .

Today, almost every medical man is overwhelmed with work. Packed surgeries and long visiting lists are the rule, not the exception.

Hence, doctors have little time (and that little they begrudge from actual healing work) to maintain records. Yet case-histories and the like have to be kept.

The problem of keeping such records with a minimum of time and effort is now greatly simplified.

Visibly-recorded Case-History and Accounts cards have just been created especially for this purpose.

Briefly, the cards are suspended on steel hangers in neat cabinets or desk books. There, while the patient sits

before you, is a comprehensive history of his case—name, address, sex, occupation, past illnesses, family history, and so forth. And there is provision for entering clinical notes, prescriptions, diagnoses and associated information.

Each card will last roughly two or so years, assuming visits average out at one a month.

Conjunctively or separately the Accounts cards record every financial transaction, as well as detailing consultations, medicines, dressings, confinements, visits, etc.

Doctors who are concerned with simplifying such work and systematizing their practice may obtain specimens of these time-saving, labour-saving cards on request.
