HOURS AFTER 300,000 UNITS OF 'PENIDURAL'







COLPOPHOTOGRAPHS AS AN INTRODUCTION TO COLPOSCOPY

By DR. MED. ROBERT GANSE (Merited Doctor of the People)

Head of the Gynaecological Clinic of the City Hospital, Dresden-Friedrichshain


