The case of Merodon equestris.

In England's south-western counties of Devon and Cornwall the growing of Spring flowers is an important industry; but one which, for many years past, has suffered considerably from the attack of the Narcissus bulb fly, M. equestris.

The flies lay their eggs in late Spring at the base of the withering leaves and the young larvæ burrow through the soil and enter the bulbs from below. Destruction is often complete. If a bulb survives, its growth the following year is restricted to a few spindly leaves and the flower crop is lost. The larvæ overwinter in the bulb and then pupate in the surrounding soil. A few weeks later the adults emerge to repeat the life cycle.

The long-standing problem of control has now been solved by using the Shell insecticide aldrin. The method is simple: add 1 pint of 30% aldrin to 20 gallons of cold water and immerse the bulbs for 15 minutes. Trials lasting through two seasons have proved the complete efficiency of this treatment which has become standard practice, not only in Devon and Cornwall, but also in other areas where narcissi and daffodils are grown commercially.


