

ANY MEDICAL PRACTITIONER knows how stubbornly resistant to any therapy a long-standing varicose ulcer can be. 





The graph above is of an experiment to measure the effect of Transvasin on skin temperature on a subject. The red line plots the skin temperature before and at intervals after a single application of one inch of cream (0.924 grams) from a tube of Transvasin. The black line gives similar information with regard to the application of a plain vanishing cream used as a control. 




