(c) JUNIOR HOSPITAL MEDICAL OFFICERS. Officers who have held house appointments but who are not registrars and who have less responsibility than other hospital officers of non-consultant status, and who have been appointed for a limited or indefinite period, not less than one year after full registration as a medical practitioner: £1,100 by £60 (8) to £1,580. Deduction of £215 per annum for compulsory residence or £255 per annum for voluntary residence.

Allowances at rates of up to £100 per annum shall be payable to house officers, senior house officers, junior hospital medical officers and registrars occupying posts approved for such allowances in peripheral hospitals.


