## **Surgery of Violence (1975)**

Injuries caused by explosive weapons may suddenly present a doctor with urgent, unfamiliar problems in the treatment of the victims. The recent experience of surgeons and physicians at the Royal Victoria Hospital, Belfast, has been drawn upon to provide advice on some important aspects of the surgery of violence. First published as a series of articles in the *BMJ* during February and March this year, they are now collated into a book. Among the subjects the authors discuss are wounds of trunk and limbs, blast injuries of the ear, intensive care, and disaster planning. In addition the book includes a bibliography of 30 recent papers on traumatic surgery written by members of the staff of the Royal Victoria Hospital.
