





Lopresor Presentation: Pale red, round film-coated tablets, each containing 50mg. Lopresor is also available as light blue round tablets, each containing 100mg. Indications: Hypertension: Initially, one 100mg tablet morning and evening should be given. The dosage may be increased to 2 x 100mg twice daily according to response. Most patients will respond to two 100mg tablets twice daily or less, particularly if Lopresor is used in conjunction with a diuretic such as chlorthalidone or a vasodilator such as hydralazine. Precautions: Cardiac failure must be controlled before initiating Lopresor therapy. Caution should be observed when treating asthmatics. It may be necessary to adjust the dosage of antidiabetic medication. As with other drugs, beta-blockers should only be used during pregnancy if there are compelling reasons.
