#### PRESCRIBING INFORMATION Dosage:

(Adults) Initially 25mg (0.5ml) by deep intramuscular injection into the gluteal region to assess susceptibility of patient. Dosage should be increased by increments of 25 or 50mg at appropriate intervals until a satisfactory response is obtained. Most patients respond to a dose of 50-100mg (1-2ml) every 4 weeks. Patients should be stabilised under psychiatric supervision

#### Contra-indications:

Marked cerebral atherosclerosis phaeochromocytoma, renal or liver failure, severe cardiac insufficiency or hypersensitivity to other phenothiazine derivatives

#### Precautions:

A history of convulsive disorders or marked extra-pyramidal reactions to oral phenothiazines. in pregnancy and lactation Side-effects:

Reversible extra-pyramidal reactions, sleep disturbance, depression, blurred vision, asthenia. impotence, dry mouth, nausea. amenorrhoea. galactorrhoea, hypotension, hyperhydrosis and weight gain have been observed occasionally. Corneal or lenticular cloudiness have not been observed with Piportil alone, but in treatment with phenothiazine preparations in high dosage over a long period. there is a risk of such sideeffects occurring. Local reactions at site of injection are rare




