

If you do, you know why Nizoral *cream* is the right answer to **seborrhoeic dermatitis**

Apply twice daily until a few days after remission of symptoms.

Indications: Nizoral cream is indicated for topical application in the treatment of dermatophyte infections of the skin, as well as in the treatment of cutaneous candidosis and tinea (pityriasis) versicolor. Nizoral *cream* is also indicated for the treatment of seborrhoeic dermatilits, a skin condition related with the presence of *Pityrosporum ovale*. **Precautions:** Irritation may occur when Nizoral *cream* is used immediately after prolonged treatment with topical corticosteroids. Therefore, it is recommended to continue applying the topical corticosteroid in the mornings and to apply Nizoral *cream* in the evenings, and to subsequently and gradually withdraw the second therapy over a period of 2-3 weeks.



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This course will aim to provide a review of areas of major interest and importance in respiratory medicine. It will also aim to provide participants with an update on the recent advances relevant to clinical practice in the fields discussed. The course will consist of talks, seminars and demonstrations and ample time will be available for discussion with the speakers either at the end of their talk or informally afterwards.

Topics to be discussed will include: smoking-related lung disease; management of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease; advances in asthma care; management of lung cancer; breathing disorders during sleep; pulmonary infections; tuberculosis in AIDS; interstitial lung disease; pulmonary embolism; occupational lung disorders.

The course will be directed by **Dr M E Sudlow**, **Dr N J Douglas**, and **Dr W MacNee** from the University Department of Respiratory Medicine at the City Hospital in Edinburgh.
