Anyone wishing to present a paper, a poster or participate in a workshop demonstration can obtain guidance on the abstract format from the organising committee.

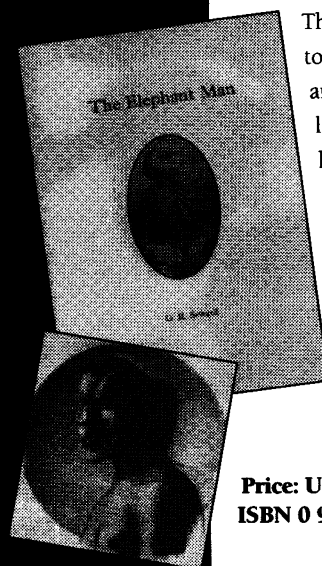
