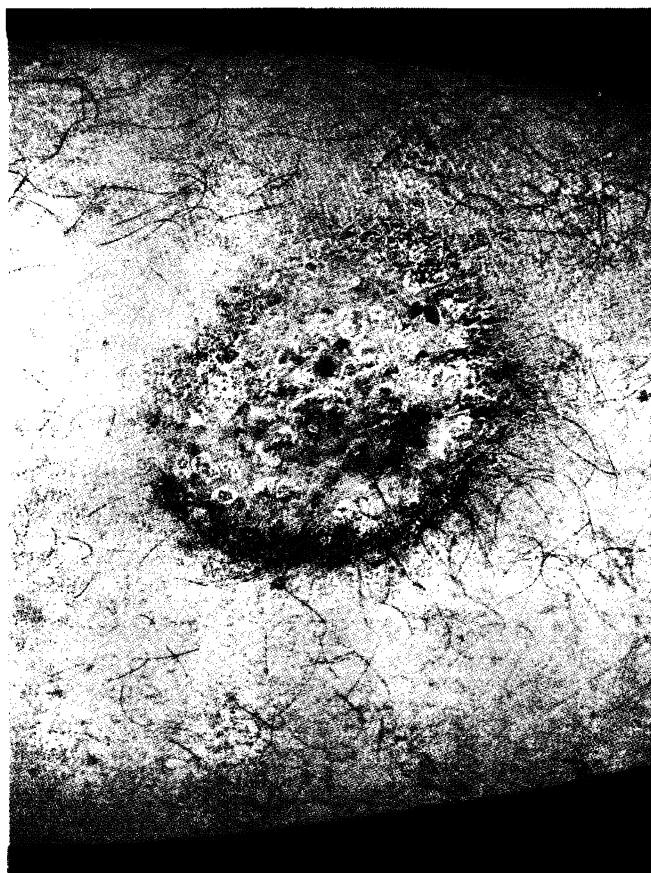

Advantages

Side effects

Corticosteroids should never be used in the presence of infection except in conjunction with effective chemotherapy. Usually the preparations are well tolerated. However, sensitisation phenomena have on very rare occasions been reported with the use of corticosteroid-containing preparations for local application. From existing reports it is difficult to determine whether or not the corticosteroid or other components were responsible. Neomycin, largely confined in its use to local application, has been reported to give rise to skin sensitisation. These occurrences, however, are rather uncommon and this antibiotic is probably one of the best tolerated when used for local application. It can be said to have a very low sensitising potential. If, by remote chance any indication of sensitisation occurs, application should be stopped immediately. When occlusive dressings are used on extensive areas, or for prolonged periods, it is desirable that, as with all topical corticosteroids, the possibility of systemic absorption should be considered.

Application

Ointment, Cream, Lotion and Scalp Application

A small quantity should be applied gently to the affected area once or twice daily until improvement occurs. It may then be possible to maintain progressive improvement using one application a day or less.

Tulle

Apply direct to the lesion and cover with an absorbent dressing if necessary.

Legal restriction
