Among the causes of death were—	bronchitis, 49; pneumonia, 40; phthisis, 133; small-pox, 11; scarlatina, 32; measles, 51; diphtheria, 4; hooping-cough, 30. The deaths from pulmonary diseases (exclusive of phthisis) were 107, being 13 above the corrected average.	
Barometer:	Highest (Mon.) 29.771; lowest (Th.) 29.552; mean 29.682.	
Thermometer:	In sun—highest (Wed.) 121.0 degrees; lowest (Mon.) 72.0 degrees. In shade—highest (Tu.) 75.0 degrees; lowest (Wed.) 50.2 degrees. Mean—59.0 degrees; difference from mean of 43 yrs.—2.6 degrees. Range—during week, 24.8 degrees; mean daily, 17.2 degrees.	
Mean humidity of air (saturation=100), 86.		
Mean direction of wind, S.W.—Rain in inches, 0.83.

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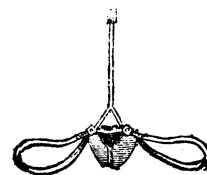
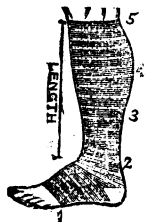
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
