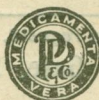
THE full therapeutic activity of the leaves of *Digitalis purpurea* is presented in Digifortis, a fat-free tincture which is 50 per cent. more active than Tincture of Digitalis of the British Pharmacopœia.

To guard against destruction of the active principles, Digifortis is packed in bottles of amber glass (which acts as a protection from actinic light rays) and air is displaced from the bottles by carbon dioxide to prevent oxidation from atmospheric influences.

The interests of the prescriber are still further safeguarded by the fact that each package is marked with the date of manufacture. Digifortis is supplied in 1-ounce bottles only.
