

INTEREST in scurvy has been stimulated in the last few years as the result of a new and broader conception of nutrition. It is clear that the subject is destined to participate in a consideration of many of the nutritional and infectious diseases of the adult and the child. For the past seven years Dr. Hess has been engaged in an investigation of scurvy both in the clinic and in the laboratory, and has treated various aspects of the subject in a large number of published articles. The time is opportune to offer to the clinician, to the hygienist, and to the biological chemist, a presentation of the existing status of this important nutritional disease, as no book on scurvy has been published in English since the classic by Lind in 1772.
