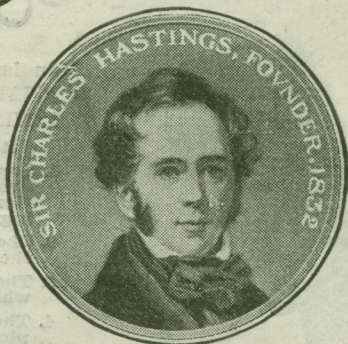

NEO-PROTOSIL

**A Non-staining Colloidal Silver Antiseptic
for the Treatment of Inflammations of Mucous Membrane**

NEO-PROTOSIL represents a great advance upon most other proteid silver compounds in that it does not produce a dark stain, whilst in bactericidal power it is at least their equal. Its solutions exhibit definite Brownian movement, and are not precipitated by sodium chloride or by urine of either acid or alkaline reaction.

NEO-PROTOSIL contains about 20 per cent. of silver iodide in a state of colloidal subdivision combined with a soluble protein base. It is in the form of cream-coloured granules, readily soluble in water. Its solutions are not irritating to mucous membrane.

NEO-PROTOSIL is serviceable in diseases of the eye, such as simple and purulent conjunctivitis, blepharitis marginalis, keratitis, etc.; in diseases of the naso-pharynx and accessory cavities, including rhinitis, tonsillitis, pharyngitis, sinusitis and gingivitis; also in the various pathological processes, simple and specific, affecting the genito-urinary apparatus.

NEO-PROTOSIL is employed in aqueous solutions ranging from 1% to 40% in strength according to the condition to be treated. NEO-PROTOSIL OINTMENT (5%) is convenient for use in disorders of the eye, ear, nose, etc., and NEO-PROTOSIL VAGINAL SUPPOSITORIES (5%) in vaginal inflammations.

NEO-PROTOSIL is supplied in bottles of $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce and 1 ounce. NEO-PROTOSIL CAPSULES—the contents of 1 capsule (6 grains) dissolved in 120 minims of water form, approximately, a 5% solution—are supplied in bottles of 25 and 100. NEO-PROTOSIL OINTMENT is supplied in collapsible tin tubes. NEO-PROTOSIL VAGINAL SUPPOSITORIES are supplied in boxes of 1 dozen.
