EDITOR'S CHOICE

BMJ

For doctors burdened with reading matter Autumn Books (p 1052) offers a guide, and Roy Porter illuminating the enigmatic Hodgkin, Alex Paton dipping into Bath's healing waters, and Richard Harding swinging to natural rhythms are among reviewers signposting the way. Tiredness is familiar to doctors, but when otherwise normal people inexplicably complain of fatigue doctors are puzzled; Stokes *et al* (p 1014) offer a lifeline. Is *Achieving a Balance* a manpower mirage? Its potentially massive cost in an anaesthetic department (p 1033) suggests

that it may be. And from Sweden we hear a disappointing story of sex discrimination in medicine in that supposedly egalitarian society (p 1041). The fragile state of occupational health research and education is highlighted from Newcastle upon Tyne (p 1043) and from the BMA (p 1050), while *The Nation's Health* is vigorously defended by two of its authors, who strike back (p 1046) at an earlier critical leading article by Professor J C A Mitchell. Finally, Fiona Cathcart (p 997) gives topical advice on the grievous question of seeing the body after death.
